ORDINANCE NO. 2010-6

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 39 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE WITH
RESPECT TO BUSINESS LICENSES**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Eastampton that the Business License application process adopted by the Township Council on December 14, 2009 pursuant to Ordinance Number 2009-10 be amended as follows:

SECTION I.

Current Section 39-3 A. shall be deleted and replaced with the following

§39-3 Application for license.

A. Application for a business license shall be made on forms to be obtained from the Township Clerk. In the case of corporations and associations, all officers, directors or stockholders owning 10% or more of the stock and members thereof shall be listed on the application. In the case of partnerships and joint ventures, all members of said partnership or joint venture shall be listed on the application. The business premises shall be subject to inspection by the Code Enforcement Officer to determine compliance with Zoning and Building Code requirements. Prior to the issuance of a business license, the applicant shall be required to obtain a zoning use permit to be signed by the Zoning Official.

SECTION II.

1. Section 39-4 A. shall be amended to delete the reference to the "Eastampton Township Police."
2. Section 39-4 A. 2 shall be deleted.
3. Section 39-4 B shall be amended to read as follows:

B. Upon completion of the inspection of the proposed business premises by the Township Code Enforcement Officer and the review of the proposed use, the Code Enforcement Officer shall recommend the issuance or denial of said license to the Township Council, setting forth his reasons therefore in writing. The Township Council shall authorize the issuance of the license or refuse to issue the license within three weeks of the date of the recommendation of the Code Enforcement Official, and the governing body shall set forth in writing the reasons for its action in authorizing or refusing said license.

SECTION III.

Each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase of this Ordinance is declared to be an independent section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase, and the finding or holding of any such portion of this Ordinance to be unconstitutional, void, or ineffective for any cause, or reason, shall not affect any other portion of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and any publication as may be required by law.

SECTION V.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
