

**ORDINANCE 2011-12  
EASTAMPTON TOWNSHIP**

**BURLINGTON COUNTY**

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION  
OF \$75,000 PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53 FOR THE  
PREPARATION OF TAX MAPS AND A CODIFICATION OF  
ORDINANCES IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF EASTAMPTON, IN  
THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
EASTAMPTON, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY, AS  
FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Township Council of the Township of Eastampton, County of Burlington, New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as the "Township"), pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53 hereby appropriates the sum of \$75,000 as an Emergency Appropriation for the purpose set forth in Section 2 hereof.

Section 2. The purposes for which said Emergency Appropriation is made are:

Purposes	Estimated Cost
1) Preparation of Tax Map Amendments of Property in the Township, including all costs, improvements, equipment and/or appurtenances necessary therefore and related thereto.	\$15,000
2) Codification of revisions of Ordinances of the Township, including all costs, improvements, equipment and/or appurtenances necessary therefore and related thereto.	\$60,000
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>\$75,000</b>

Section 3. The purposes described in Section 2 of this ordinance are not current expenses and is property or improvements which the Township may lawfully make, and no part of the cost thereof has been or shall be specially assessed on property specially benefitted thereby.

Section 4. Any grant or other moneys received for the purposes described in Section 2 hereof, shall be applied either to direct payment of the cost of the purpose.

Section 5. To the extent that any previous ordinance or resolution is inconsistent with or contradictory hereto, said ordinance or resolution is hereby repealed or amended to the extent necessary to make it consistent herewith.

Section 6. The provisions of this ordinance are severable. To the extent any clause, phrase, sentence, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be declared invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect at the time and in the manner prescribed by law.
