ORDINANCE NO. 2015-2

TOWNSHIP OF EASTAMPTON

BURLINGTON COUNTY

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE XVII, SECTION 5-45, "ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE"

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Eastampton, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION I.

Section 5-45 of the Township Code entitled "Economic Development Advisory Committee" is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

5-45 Economic Development Advisory Committee

A. Membership; Terms; Chairperson.

(1) There shall be an Economic Development Advisory Committee ("EDAC") consisting of six members to be appointed by the Township Council. Membership shall include the following:

(a) Class A: a person who is knowledgeable in economic development and regional planning and who may reside outside the Township. Class A members shall be nonvoting members.

(b) Class B: one member of the Township Council.

(c) Class C: Township Manager.

(d) Class D: one member of the Land Use Planning Board.

(2) Class E: Two members who shall hold no other municipal office, position or employment. The terms of the initial appointments for these members shall not exceed two years and shall be staggered; thereafter, Class E members shall be appointed for a two year term.

(3) Members shall be appointed annually with the exception of Class E members who shall be appointed for a 2-year term.

(4) The Township Council shall annually appoint one of the Class E members as Chairperson of the Committee.

B. Three voting members shall constitute the required quorum to conduct business.

C. The EDAC shall select a Secretary who need not be a member of the EDAC or a municipal employee.

D. The EDAC shall be responsible for the following:

(1) Make recommendations to the Land Use Planning Board on the economic development plan element of the Eastampton Township Municipal Master Plan, which shall be developed and approved pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:55D-28b(8).

(2) Upon the request of the Township Council or Township Manager, and in advance of the submission of any formal development applications, meet with prospective developers to provide an orientation to the goals and objectives of the economic development plan element and other related official planning documents.

(3) Provide a report to the Land Use Planning Board, Township Council and Township Manager consisting of a summary of any preliminary meetings and, upon request, provide advisement regarding the consistency of formal development applications with respect to the goals and objectives of the economic development plan element and other planning documents.

(4) Recommend to the Township Council any other advisory, educational or informational functions as will enhance the economic vitality and sustainability of Eastampton Township.

SECTION II.

Should any section, part of any section, or clause or phrase of this ordinance for any reason be held invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION III.

Any and all other ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION IV.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and any publication as may be required by law.

SECTION V.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
