**TOWNSHIP OF EASTAMPTON
BURLINGTON COUNTY**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EASTAMPTON
TO AMEND THE SALARY AND WAGE ORDINANCE
OF THE UNION EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EASTAMPTON**

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A 9-165 permits a municipality to establish salaries, wages, or compensation to be paid to the officers and employees of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council and Township Manager have made a careful examination of the salaries, wages, and compensation appropriate to compensation of said employees; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Eastampton, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 8: All ordinances of the Township of Eastampton which are inconsistent with the provisions of the ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of each inconsistency.

Section 9: If any chapter, article, division, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or provision of the ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect all remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 10. The ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final passage, approval, and publication after adoption by the Township Council and shall be retroactive to January 1, 2015.
