

EASTAMPTON TOWNSHIP COUNCIL
REGULAR SESSION MINUTES
Tuesday, October 12, 2010
7:30 p.m.

Mayor Springer called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Mayor Springer certified that the meeting was published in the Burlington County Times on January 8, 2010. Notice was posted on the Municipal Bulletin Board. All requirements of the "Open Public Meetings Act" were satisfied.

Present were: Mayor Jay Springer, Deputy Mayor Louise Campbell, Council Member Joseph Maroccia,. Also present were: Township Attorney Eileen Fahey and Township Manager Scott Carew. Municipal Clerk Kim-Marie White was absent. Council Members Keith Nagler and Council Member Walter Tafe were absent.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

TOWNSHIP MANAGER'S REPORT:

Township Manager Carew said the new cell phones have been received and distributed. He would provide a list of the phone numbers for Council.

Township Manager Carew said he ordered 825 recycling carts which includes fifteen smaller ones for those who need them.

Township Manager Carew said he went to the Princeton Label Company in Robbinsville and had a tour of the facility. He said it is apparent why they need more room after he had the tour.

Township Manager Carew said they are hiring a Class II Officer for one day a week. They are also hiring Judy Taylor to help out in the Police Dept; she would be working one day a week.

Township Manager Carew said the meeting with Greg Gramaldi from Connor Strong has been pushed back. In order to retrieve the records the cost is \$2,000 per health insurance fund and the township has three, the total for them to examine the records would be \$6,000.

Township Manager Carew said the mercury vapor lights need to be upgraded at no cost to the township.

Township Manager Carew said at the next Township Council meeting Council would need to adopt an emergency appropriation for the professional legal costs. Whatever amount they adopt would be raised in the 2011 budget.
