Eastampton Township News is generally published on a monthly basis to provide residents with pertinent information and reminders related to Eastampton Township and the surrounding area. The Township views this as another important means of keeping residents informed about our community.

1. **REMINDER: Primary Election Day is Tuesday, June 5.** Polls are open from 6:00am to 8:00pm. For further information, including polling locations, call (609) 267-5723, ext. 209.
2. **Eastampton Township Hosted a Memorial Day Service on Friday, May 25.** Mayor Robert Apgar, Township Council, the Eastampton Recreation Advisory Committee and the Eastampton Veterans and Military Affairs Advisory Committee coordinated the annual service to commemorate the men and women who died while serving our country. Mayor and Council, Chief Boatswain Mate (Ret.) R. Todd Holm, and representatives of the Eastampton Fire Department, Eastampton Police Department and Eastampton Veterans and Military Affairs Advisory Committee laid wreaths at Veterans Park across from the Manor House on Manor House Court. Chief Boatswain Mate (Ret.) R. Todd Holm was presented with a Mayoral Proclamation for receiving the Bronze Star Medal from the United States Army.



3. **New Jersey American Water is Performing Routine Flushing of Their Water Distribution System.** The flushing, currently scheduled for **June 4 – June 16**, will ensure that residents continue to receive high-quality water service. Flushing also allows American Water to monitor and maintain fire hydrants. When crews are working, residents may notice reduced pressure or discolored water. If your water is discolored, wait until it runs clear before using. This should typically take only a few minutes. 4. **Eastampton Township Co-Sponsors Fishing Tournament on Saturday, June 9 at Iron Works Park in Mount Holly.** The annual event, co-sponsored by several area municipalities, will be held from 6:30am to 12:00pm. 5. **Eastampton Township Brush Collection.** Due to several unforeseen circumstances, the Public Works Department has been operating well below typical work force levels. The Township has recently taken steps to address this unfortunate situation and the department is catching up on our brush collection service as quickly as possible. For the time being, the normal brush collection schedule has been suspended. As such, residents will see both our chipper and trash trucks collecting brush throughout the week. **However, please understand that trash trucks cannot collect brush while they are collecting normal trash due to the manner in which the material is required to be disposed.** Your patience while we address our current work force condition is greatly appreciated. 6. **PSE&G Announces Gas Service Project to Begin On or About June 11.** PSE&G will be installing new gas services along Woodlane Road, from Jacksonville Road to Smithville Road. Work will be conducted Monday through Friday from 9:00am to 6:00pm. Motorists should expect delays due to alternating traffic and signed detours. 7. **Attention Residents: Trash Collection Schedule for Week of 4<sup>th</sup> of July.** Township offices are closed on **Wednesday, July 4**. Therefore, trash collection for all residents whose trash is normally collected on Wednesday will be collected on **Friday, July 6**. Tuesday and Thursday trash will not be affected. 13. **Fieldstone Associates, LLC Continues Site Work on Eastampton Place West on Woodlane Road, the Former Gregory's Furniture Site.** Fieldstone Associates, LLC received Land Use Planning Board approval for a mix-use project on the site. "Eastampton Place West" consists of 7 buildings totaling approximately 383,000 square feet, including over 12,000 square feet of commercial space, a 4,300 square foot clubhouse and 240 **market-rate** luxury apartment units ranging from 800 to 1,400 square feet each. The property is located adjacent to the existing Dunkin Donuts on Woodlane Road. Occupancy is scheduled to begin in 2018. Work is scheduled to be performed on weekdays, weather permitting, from 7am to 4pm. Work will occasionally be conducted on Saturdays during the same hours. Township Engineer Environmental Resolutions is managing project oversight.
  
14. **Holgate Development, LLC Continues Construction on Eastampton Village II and III on Woodlane Road.** The project, consisting of 8 **market-rate** single family homes and 55 **market-rate** townhomes, constructed by Ryan Homes, is located adjacent to the existing Sharbell development. Work is scheduled to be performed on weekdays, weather permitting, from 7am to 4pm. Work will occasionally be conducted on Saturdays during the same hours. Although vehicular traffic may be impacted in this area, roads will remain open throughout the project. Township Engineer Environmental Resolutions is managing project oversight.
