It is illegal for a trash collector to pick up trash mixed with recyclables.

**NO LOOSE** SHREDDED PAPER  
IT MAKES A MESS!



**NO** PLASTIC PAILS, TUBS, TRAYS, FOOD CONTAINERS OR FOIL ITEMS

IMPORTANT: **Do not recycle** #1 & #2 TUBS AND TRAYS AND **ANY** #3 THRU #7 PLASTICS. We must send them to the landfill.



**NO** BULBS, DISHES, GLASSWARE OR WINDOW GLASS



**NO** MOTOR OIL, PAINT OR PESTICIDE CONTAINERS



**NO** PLASTIC WRAP OR STYROFOAM

USE BUCKET SUPPLIED BY MUNICIPALITY

PLEASE RINSE LABELS ARE OKAY

**NO CAPS OR LIDS**

**DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS**

## REMEMBER

One truck collects paper – another collects bottles & cans



THEY JAM UP OUR SORTING EQUIPMENT  
RECYCLE AT GROCERY STORES



Set cart at least 3 FEET from buckets, mailboxes, basketball systems, cars, etc.

## PAPER AND CARDBOARD

PUT ALL PAPER/BOXES IN BLUE CART

FLATTEN BOXES SO EVERYTHING FITS

**SET CART OUT SO METAL BAR FACES THE STREET**

Recycling containers are municipal property

If used for trash, they will not be collected

If you move, your cart must stay behind
