

2013 BRUSH CHIPPING SCHEDULE

- Program starts and will continue on the first Monday of every month. Every street will be collected once. Due to volume of material, collection could take two weeks or more.
- Brush should be no larger than (8) eight inches in diameter, and should be four (4) feet long or longer
- Brush should be piled curbside as not to block view or traffic with all cut ends facing the same direction. Because the brush will be fed into the chipper cut end first, all cut ends should be facing away from traffic, for ease of loading. If possible, this should be done the weekend prior to the collection date, to prevent piles from sitting for long periods of time at curbside.
- **All vines, bamboo, and root balls must be removed.**
- **The Township will not collect large piles as a result of any large landscaping projects or commercially cut brush. Tree service contractors must remove any material cut for the homeowner.**
- Small sticks, vines, and small shrubs can still be disposed of through regular trash collection, as long as they are bagged or tied in bundles weighing less than fifty (50) pounds. Bundles should be no longer than (3) three feet in length.
- Any material placed curbside that does not meet these requirements **will not be collected.**
