*Eastampton Recreation welcomes you and your child to the Summer Park Program.
All children must be residents of Eastampton*

Time 9 AM to 12 Noon

Attendance is voluntary on a daily basis. It will not be necessary for you to notify anyone if your child cannot attend on any given day. Attendance is taken each day of the program, so we are always aware of who is present.

Groups Youngest 5 - 7 yr.
(child 5 years old must have completed kindergarten)
Middle 8 - 10 yr.
Oldest 11 - 13 yr.

Each group has counselors to accommodate the number of children in a group.

PROGRAM COST

The full cost for the Eastampton Summer Park Program is \$175.00 per child which includes the fee for all weekly trips. There are no refunds issued for any reason.

Yellow T-shirts may be purchased for trips at \$10.00 each.

REGISTRATION

*Fill out one registration form for each child (2 pages). Staple the two pages together.
Do NOT staple two separate registrations together and do NOT staple checks to the forms.
Decide if your child needs a yellow shirt to go on the trips.
Make out a check for the full amount to EASTAMPTON TOWNSHIP
If you have more than one child registered, you may add the amounts on one check.
Place your registration form/s and check in an envelope
Deliver to the Manor House, Recreation, no later than Friday, June 7, 2013.*

T-SHIRTS

Yellow T-shirts - for children to wear to trips for easy identification.

TRIPS

Information for each trip is in the program calendar available at the Manor House.

Yellow shirt - We encourage children to wear the yellow T-shirt on trips for easy Identification.

Parents - Parents are encouraged to attend especially with young children. (Please speak to the Director in advance)

The program is **NOT** in session for children who choose not to go on a trip.

RAIN

*In case of rain the program is held indoors at the School. If a storm develops while the program is in session, unfortunately, we have no means of getting children indoors, your child will be sent home early. Please make arrangements with your child, as to what he/she should do, if this occurs. **NOTICE:** Any information about the Recreation building, will be presented on the first day of camp by the Director.*

SAFETY

We want every child to have an enriching experience and consider safety to be of utmost importance. The following rules and regulations will be maintained.

RULES OF THE SUMMER PARK PROGRAM

- ❖ *No alcoholic beverages*
- ❖ *No water bottles*
- ❖ *No smoking*
- ❖ *No defacing or destroying of park or park property*
- ❖ *No rough-housing or horseplay*
- ❖ *No motorized vehicles of any type*
- ❖ *No profanity*
- ❖ *No matches, fires, or fireworks*
- ❖ *No glass breaking*
- ❖ *No littering*
- ❖ *No bikes, skates, skate-boards, or refreshments on tennis courts*
- ❖ *Sneakers must be worn on tennis courts*

You and your child will be held responsible and accountable to follow these and any other safety measures that are deemed necessary. Please make sure he/she is aware of them.

- ❖ *If a child violates a rule the staff will counsel him/her and a note will be sent to the parents the first time.*
- ❖ *If the child violates a rule a second time, a notice will be sent home and the parents must speak with the Director of the Summer Park Program.*
- ❖ *If there should be a third episode, the child will not be allowed to attend the rest of the program for that season.*

Physical Violence:

- ❖ *If a child is physically violent to anyone, he/she will be suspended from the program for the rest of the current season and for one year following the occurrence.*
- ❖ *There will be no fee refund if any of the above occurs.*
- ❖ *Your signature on the registration form indicates you agree to these terms.*

LATE PICKUP

- ❖ *We have no arrangements for children later than 12 Noon each day.*
- ❖ *Please make arrangements if you cannot pick your child up on time.*
- ❖ *Arrangements would include a signed note from you with the person who is to pick the child up.*
- ❖ *Children who are not picked up on time, in excess of three (3) times, will not be able to continue in the program.*
- ❖ *There will be no fee refund if this occurs.*

EARLY PICKUP

- ❖ *Do not pick up your child before 12 noon sharp.*
- ❖ *If it is necessary to pick your child up early, see the Director before doing so.*

DRESS CODE

- ❖ *Children are to be dressed in appropriate shoes and clothing for outdoor play. **No flip flops or open toed shoes. Please have child wear sneakers.***
